Important messages

Parking

We sent out an important message on OurSchoolApp and Seesaw on 8th November which stated: Risedale School has been issued notice by their school coach company that they will no longer collect or drop off their students in their car park due to scheduling delays and safety concerns as a result of parents parking in the cycle and coach lanes. I'm sure you will appreciate that this is a major concern for Risedale School. Please do not park in the cycle or coach lanes at any time if using their car park. Where possible, please park on Shute Road and walk up the snicket. My concern is that Risedale School will completely ban parents from using their car park.

Unfortunately, parents are still parking in both the cycle lane (to the left of the entrance gate) and the coach lane. Please do not park in these areas **at any time**.
