Admissions Policy

Our vision is to "Live generously and graciously towards others, the way God lives towards us" (Matthew 5:48). We nurture supportive relationships within our often-changing community. We aspire for our children to be resilient and to flourish - happily, confidently and with enthusiasm.

Admissions to Hipswell School are administered by North Yorkshire County Council who are the Admissions Authority for the school.

Reception (FS2) Pupils

Children may be admitted to the Reception class at the beginning of the academic year where their fifth birthday falls between 1st September and 31st August. When a place is offered in any school, admission is offered for the beginning of the September term following the child's fourth birthday. Parents have the choice whether to take that place in the September or to defer admission until later in the same academic year or until the start of the term after the child's fifth birthday.

Parents need to apply for a Reception Place directly to North Yorkshire County Council Admissions via their website.

Parents <u>MUST</u> apply to North Yorkshire Local Authority for a place for their child at Hipswell Church of England Primary School.

Our published admission number for the Reception class is 30 pupils. Head teachers cannot offer your child a place or guarantee the availability of a place at their school.
