Our school's legal duties under the Equality Act 2010

The <u>Equality Act 2010</u> prohibits discrimination against an individual based on the protected characteristics, which include sex, race, religion or belief, and gender reassignment.

Expectations for school uniform (throughout the year)

- Red jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt (required)
- White or red shirt or polo shirt (required)
- Black or grey trousers, skirt or pinafore (required)
- Black shoes or plain black trainers. For safety reasons, shoes should be flat (required)
- Children may bring outdoor shoes or wellies for playtimes on the field (optional)

PE Kit (throughout the year)

- White t-shirt (required)
- Black shorts (required)
- Plimsolls for inside activities (required)
- Trainers for outdoor games activities (required)
- PE kit should be in school daily
- Children may bring dark tracksuit bottoms and a warm top for colder weather (optional)
- Earrings must be removed for safety during PE lessons

Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly named.

Jewellery and hairstyles

For their own safety, children are not allowed to wear jewellery. If ears are pierced, small studs may be worn. These must be removed during PE lessons. Where possible, please pierce children's ears at the start of the summer holidays so that they do not miss PE lessons due to not being able to remove earrings.

Long hair must be tied back for PE lessons. Hair should be appropriate for school and styled smartly.

Please ensure that items are clean, clearly labelled with the child's name and remain in good condition.
