

Dear Parents

Thank you for your patience, understanding and support with the arrangements and routines for the re-opening of the whole school. I know it has been extremely challenging but I am so grateful for everyone's support.

I would like to clarify the following information.

School dinners: From Monday 14th September, children can order their hot meal on the actual day. Advance orders via e-mail are still very welcome. This is a great help for Mrs Pownall, our excellent school cook who has to order the food in advance.

Please remember that all pupils in the Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a **FREE** school meal (universal free school meal). The cost of a hot meal for KS2 pupils is £2.60 per day.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils also receive a FREE daily piece of fruit. KS2 children can bring in a healthy snack such as fruit into school or buy a healthy snack (30p) and a drink (30p) for their morning break.

Pupils should only bring a small bag to school.

Pupils should not bring antibacterial hand wash to school.

Please remember that pupils have been asked to come to school wearing their normal school uniform with training shoes.

Please follow the social distancing measures at the beginning and end of the school day.
